

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE HON'BLE HIGH COURT TO DETERMINE SUITABILITY OF NURSING COLLEGES IN M.P. HELD AT HOTEL ASHOKA, BHOPAL ON 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025**

Chairman Jst. Sh. Srivastava and Member Sh. RS Julaniya present in person. Member Sh. Tripathi attended by video conferencing. The Nodal Officer Dr. C.P. Shukla presented cases of the Colleges.

The Committee heard each of the above representatives, perused the records submitted with their representations, queried about buildings, infrastructure, facilities, faculty, sanctioned seats in different nursing education programs and students presently studying in their colleges.

After careful consideration of the records and facts as they appeared before the Committee, and affording ample opportunity to present their cases, the Committee arrived at the following conclusions:

Photos and documents support the contention that the College has removed deficiencies relating to building, area of class rooms, labs, computer room, common rooms.<br>Documents show that the Principal and Vice Principal have requisite eligibility. Vouchers supports procurement of articles and equipments for labs and books for library. Documents support eligibility of faculty. Dr. Patil admitted that the bed occupancy in parent hospital is negligible.   |
| 4 | BR College of Nursing, Morena                  | Removal of deficiency cannot be -determined without surprise site inspection.   | The deficiencies noted by CBI relate to inadequate built-up area, small size of multipurpose hall, inadequacies of articles and equipments in laboratories, ineligible teaching faculty, admitting students without permission of MPNRC, and not sending students for clinical training, etc.<br>The College runs only GNM program. Director Mr. Yadav stated that present built-up area of 15111 sq ft coupled with rental arrangement for multipurpose hall suffices for GNM program. He submitted vouchers of procurement of material for labs and appointment of a new Principal. Truthfulness of the assertions made by Director Mr. Yadav needs verification at site. |
| 5 | Shri Maharaj Singh College of Nursing, Gwalior | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without surprise site inspection.  | The deficiencies noted by CBI relate to inadequate built-up area of only 12741 Sq. Ft., small sizes of class rooms/labs, inadequacies of library, poor bed occupancy of parent hospital and no arrangement for hostel facility.<br>The College runs only GNM program. Mr. Yadav stated that a new building of the College is under construction. In the interim, the College has taken a building on rent for a year. Bed occupancy of parent hospital is poor because it falls in rural area. It has recruited required faculty.<br>Truthfulness of the documents submitted by the College seems doubtful and needs verification at site.                                  |
| 6 | RMD Jain Institute of Nursing, Bhopal          | Suitable.   | The land lease agreement covers activities allied to medical college and therefore, the Committee notes that interpretation of CBI relating to exclusion of allied medical health education is not reasonable. The College has removed the deficiency of temporary nature of partitions by constructing pukka walls and procured articles/equipments for lab.   |



| 7  | Gurukul Academy of Nursing Science, Burhanpur    | Suitable.  | <p>The College was found unsuitable by CBI for deceitfully getting the CBI team to inspect its nursing College running in the same building where it is running a Higher Secondary School.</p> <p>From the documents and photos submitted by the College the Committee is satisfied that the High School and Nursing College buildings are distinct and separate.</p>   |
| 8  | School of Nursing Christian Hospital, Chhatarpur | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection.  | <p>CBI noted deficiencies of building area (available only 4,918.79 sq.ft.); deficiencies of area, articles and equipments in labs; non-availability of Av-Aid lab and no clinical training, etc.</p> <p>The College has its parent hospital and claims to have arranged an adjacent building of 6,000 sq.ft. besides shifting its lab to ground floor. The photos/documents do not conclusively prove the contentions. Hence, the Committee felt that without site visit removal of deficiencies cannot be ascertained.</p>  |
| 9  | Radha krishna Nursing College, Sendhwa, Barwani  | Site visit is felt necessary to verify the contentions of the College.   | <p>The Committee in its meeting dated 12/14 Sep. 2024 found the College unsuitable on account of non-availability of regular faculty, negligible bed occupancy in its parent hospital and non-availability of facility for transportation of students for clinical training. The College approached the Hon'ble high Court against the findings of the Committee. Noting that the College was considered unsuitable only for want of bus facility, the Hon'ble Court directed, vide its order dated 12.12.2024, the College to satisfy the Committee regarding removal of deficiency. Representation dated 04.02.2025 of the College mentions only removal of bus related deficiency.</p> <p>The Committee noted that its earlier findings, as noted above, were not based solely on non-availability of transport facility for clinical training of students. The deficiencies relating to faculty and functional hospital for clinical training continue.</p> <p>The College asserted that the hospital bed occupancy is 70% and faculty is regular. However, documents do not support these.</p> |
| 10 | Sukh Sagar College of Nursing, Jabalpur          | Allowed 4 weeks on the request of the College and decided to also make a surprise visit to verify faculty availability and bed occupancy in parent hospital. | <p>The Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 23.01.2025 in WP No. 2300 of 2025 directed the Committee to decide the representation dated 19.01.2025 of the College. The Committee noted that the College did not send any representation on 19.01.2025.</p> <p>The Committee considered the representation dated 28.01.025 and noted that the College continues to be short in terms of class room sizes required for the</p>   |

It stated that it has removed other deficiencies.   |
| 12 | Shri Krishna College, Mungawali                       | Removal of deficiency cannot be ascertained without surprise site inspection. | CBI found the College unsuitable. On 11.02.2025, on the request of the College before this Committee, a copy of CBI findings was given to the College.<br>CBI noted inadequate area (9,169 sq. ft.), college running in a school building, inadequate area of class rooms, labs, library, and Principal room, etc., inadequacies of library, irregular faculty, not finding any faculty or student on inspection, no clinical training, and distance from the affiliated hospital, etc.<br>The College submitted documents and photos which are haphazard and their contents do not prima-facie give an impression of removal of deficiencies. |
