The Committee heard each of the above representatives, perused the records submitted with their representations, queried about buildings, infrastructure, facilities, faculty, sanctioned seats in different nursing education programs and students presently studying in their colleges.

After careful consideration of the records and facts as they appeared before the Committee, and affording ample opportunity to present their cases, the Committee arrived at the following conclusions:

| 1 | Dr. MB Sharma Nursing College, Ratlam | Not suitable for MSc program | Negligible bed occupancy of parent hospital. The top floor is temporary building not suitable for class rooms. |

| | | Subject to bed allocation from eligible government hospitals | Available building with pucca roof has 8 class rooms and a multipurpose hall where classes can be held. The building with pucca roof suffices for all programs other than for MSc program. |
| 2 | Maharana Pratap School of Nursing, Bhopal | Suitable for limited number of seats in view of limitations of practical training facilities. | From the photos and documents submitted by the College the Committee felt that deficiencies relating to building, facilities and articles/equipments in labs have been remedied. However, the deficiency of negligible bed occupancy of its 100 bedded parent hospital continues. The parent hospital is not suitable for practical training. However, the College has bed affiliation from 60 bedded Rudraksh Hospital which is reported to be having good bed occupancy. |
| 3 | Rahat College of Nursing, Khargone | Suitable | The Committee felt satisfied with regard to removal of deficiencies noted by CBI team, and also with regard to availability of faculty, bed occupancy in parent hospital and bed allocation for practical training of students from government hospital. |
| 4 | MM School of Nursing, Jabalpur | Time of 6 weeks allowed to the College on its request. | The College did not bring documents/geo-tagged photos to support its representation. On its request the Committee decided to allow time. |
| 5 | Mar Baselious College of Nursing, Bhopal | Time of 6 weeks allowed to the College on its request. | The Committee is satisfied with regard to removal of deficiencies of building permissions. However, the College could not produce proof of removal of other deficiencies and requested for time to present its case. |
| 6 | Lord Buddha School of Nursing, Rewa | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. | While submissions made during the hearing and perusal of photos support the contention of removal of infrastructure related deficiencies, the class rooms are long with narrow width. The Committee apprehends that the class rooms may not be suitable for education. Further, the Committee felt the need for verifying bed occupancy of parent hospital. |
| 7 | Swami Vivekanand College of Nursing, Shahdol | Subject to bed allocation from district hospital suitable. | The Committee is satisfied with regard to removal of deficiencies noted by CBI team. The College has required built-up area, and arranged a multipurpose hall on rent. It has procured articles, equipments and books to remove other deficiencies. |

| 8 | Gyanodaya Institute of Nursing, Neemuch | Suitable. | The College representative asserted that it has no student presently in MSc program and would not seek sanction for MSc program. Photos and documents submitted by the College show that it has arranged an adjacent building block of the Society for nursing education thereby removed all building and infrastructure related deficiencies. |
| 9 | Mehcko College of Nursing, Bhopal | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. | Removal or otherwise of the deficiencies found by CBI team include hospital and college running in the same building on the same floor, very small class rooms and fake patients in the hospital can be ascertained only by sudden site inspection. |
| 10 | RBS Institute of Nursing, Neemuch | Suitable except for MSc program. | To prove removal of deficiencies relating to availability/size of rooms and labs, the College submitted documents and photos. The College informed that it does not want to run MSc program. Available faculty suffices for students of BSc and GNM programs. |
| 11 | SSV Nursing College, Shivpuri | Suitable for GNM program | The College stated that it has removed building related all deficiencies by internal relocation and internal alteration to expand room sizes and shifting most labs on first floor. According to submissions the library is on the lower ground floor (not basement) which is well lit and has good ventilation. The Committee is satisfied as the photos and map submitted by the College support its contentions. |
| 12 | Shri Krishna College of Nursing, Ashoknagar | Time allowed to the College to submit its representation. | The College appeared pursuant to the orders dated 17.01.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 960/2025. The College was found unsuitable by CBI team. It stated that it has not received CBI inspection report or the grounds on which it was found unsuitable. The Committee directed its Nodal Officer to apprise the College on findings of CBI inspection, and allowed time to the College to submit its representation. |
| 13 | Vishal Vate Memorial College of Nursing, Bhopal | Time allowed to the College on its request. | Perusal of documents, map and photos of building submitted by the College show that the College continues to be deficient both of sizes of the class rooms and their numbers. The College requested for 2-month time to remedy the deficiencies noted by CBI team. |

The Committee heard each of the above representatives, perused the records submitted with their representations, queried about buildings, infrastructure, facilities, faculty, sanctioned seats in different nursing education programs and students presently studying in their colleges.


After careful consideration of the records and facts as they appeared before the Committee, and affording ample opportunity to present their cases, the Committee arrived at the following conclusions:

| 1 | Gyanodaya Institute of Professional Studies, Dewas | Subject to allocation of beds from government hospitals the College is suitable for a maximum strength of 45 students for BSc and GNM programs. | The College stated that deficiencies of building and room sizes have been removed by alterations in the building, programs other than nursing have been shifted to a new adjacent building and procurement has been done to remove deficiencies of articles/equipments for its labs. Photos and documents support these contentions. The Committee finds that as against the required 7 class rooms each of 1140 square feet for a class of 60 students the College has 7 class rooms of area ranging between 1046 to 1112 feet square only. These class rooms can accommodate 60 students in any program. To this deficiency the College made a written submission that it would run the programs for the present students in 2 shifts. With this, the Committee is satisfied with regard to removal of deficiencies. |
| 2 | Varma Union Nursing College, Indore | Suitable for GNM program. MPNRC to submit proposal for shifting of 30 BSc students to other suitable college. | The case was examined for GNM program only as per directions dated 09.09.2024 of the Hon'ble Court in WP No. 25629 of 2024. Documents and photos submitted by the College support its contention regarding removal of deficiencies relating to built-up area and library. Available faculty suffices for 30 seats of GNM program. |
| 3 | Arogya Nursing College, Sagar | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. | CBI found the College unsuitable for want of required built-up area, faculty, class rooms sizes, and equipments in labs, etc. The College stated that there is no hospital running in the College building and it has removed all deficiencies. Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. |
| 4 | Gyan Vihar College of Nursing, Bhainsoda Mandi, Mandasaur | Time of 4 weeks allowed to the College on its request. | Documents and photos submitted by the College were seen. The College requested for time. |
| 5 | Ayushman Nursing College, Jaisingh Nagar, Shahdol | Not considered in view of the orders of the Hon'ble Court. | The order dated 23.01.2025 of the Hon'ble Court in WP No. 2170 of 2025 directed the College to approach the respondent authorities (MPNRC/Govt). There is no direction of the Hon'ble Court to the College to satisfy the Committee regarding removal of deficiencies. |
| 6 | Vaishnav Mata Mahavidhyalaya Nursing, Panna | Suitable for GNM program. | The College runs only GNM program. Photos and documents produced by the College support the contention of the College that a new building has been constructed removing all deficiencies relating to building and area of rooms, labs, library, etc. and procurement has been done to remedy the deficiencies of library and labs as noted by CBI. |

| 7 | Bansal Academy of Nursing Sciences & Learning, Jabalpur | Unsuitable. | <p>The College was found unsuitable by CBI for want of requisite building area, small sizes of class rooms, labs, etc. and non-availability of room for principal and common room for students. It is seen that the College obtained order dated 12.12.2024 of the Hon'ble Court in Review WP No. 1454 of 2024 stating that the College has constructed a new building which fulfills all the requirements. The Hon'ble Court directed the College to satisfy this Committee that the new building constructed by the College fulfills the requirements.</p> <p>The Committee noted that the College has not constructed any new building but has arranged an existing building on rent. MPNRC recognition rules allow rented building only for a maximum period of 5 years within which the College has to have its owned building.</p> <p>The College fails to meet this requirement and continues to be deficient for want of a suitable owned building.</p> |
| 8 | BM School of Nursing, Vidisha | The Committee does not have the mandate to consider the case. | <p>The Committee in its earlier meeting dated 11 to 14 Jan. 2025 considered the representation of the College on written submissions only and found it unsuitable. The College requested for affording in-person hearing which the Committee accepted keeping in view the principles of natural justice. In the meeting dated 27th January 2025 the Chairman appeared without any faculty and requested for time to present its case. The Hon'ble Court in its order dated 10.02.2025 in WP No. 1108/2025 clarified that this Committee is to consider the case of any college only once. In view of this order of the Hon'ble Court, this Committee does not have the mandate to consider the representation.</p> |
| 9 | Shri Sai College of Nursing, Khargone | Unsuitable | <p>The Committee noted that the College building is rental one, and class rooms in the rental building do not fulfil the minimum required area. MPNRC recognition rules allow rented building only for a maximum period of 5 years within which the College has to have its owned building. More than 7 years have lapsed since the first sanction obtained by the College. The College could not satisfy the Committee regarding removal of deficiencies regarding eligible faculty either. Therefore, the Committee finds the College unsuitable.</p> |

| 10 | Narayanan Nursing College, Bahadarpur, Gwalior | Time of 4 weeks allowed to the College on its request. | The College runs only GNM program. The College submitted photos and documents but did not provide deficiency wise remedy status. The College requested for time. |
| 11 | Arogyam Nursing College, Gwalior | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. | The deficiencies noted by CBI relate to rental building for short duration and non-functional parent hospital. The College submitted copy of the rent agreement for building for 5-year duration. CBI findings informed to the Committee are sketchy based on which suitability of the rental building for GNM program cannot be ascertained. Similarly, the functionality of parent hospital can be ascertained only by sudden inspection. |
| 12 | ITM University, Gwalior | Facts may be brought to the notice of the Hon'ble Court for further directions. | Representation of the College is pursuant to order dated 10 th Jan 2025 of the Hon'ble High Court in WP no. 1101/2025. The Hon'ble Court passed the Order under the impression that the College was inspected by CBI team on 23.10.2024. The College clarified that its inspection was never carried out by CBI. Since no CBI inspection of the College has taken place, there arises no question of examining removal of deficiencies (observed by the CBI team) by the College. |
| 13 | NS School of Nursing, Kulaith, Gwalior | The Committee does not have the mandate to consider the case. | The College submitted a copy of the order dated 10 th January 2025 of the Hon'ble Court in WP No. 1211 of 2025. The College submitted a copy of the request made to Registrar, MPNRC for apprising it of the deficiencies observed by the CBI team. The above order of the Court does not contain any direction to the Committee to consider any request or representation of the College. |
| 14 | Grantham School of Nursing, Gwalior | Removal of deficiency cannot be determined without site inspection. | The deficiencies noted by CBI relate to inadequate building area, small sizes of class rooms, inadequacies of labs, inadequacies of faculty and non-functional parent hospital. Adequacy and effectiveness of the remedial measures mentioned by the College cannot be ascertained from the documents and photos submitted by the College. The parent/affiliated hospitals are functional or otherwise can be ascertained only by sudden inspection. |
